MCE Deep Green Rates

Deep Green Premium

Customers electing the Deep Green 100% renewable energy service option will pay the applicable rate for the Light Green service option plus the following Deep Green energy charge.

All Usage* as above plus \$0.01/kWh

*Deep Green costs an additional penny per kilowatt-hour in addition to MCE's standard Light Green rates. Based on a monthly usage of 1,245 kWh per month, Deep Green would cost an additional \$12.45 more per month.

Other Rate Information

PG&E Electric Rates

MCE does not provide a listing of PG&E's generation or non-generation rates, as those rates are subject to change over the course of the year. The most up-to-date information on these rates can be located within PG&E's tariff sheets, available on their website at: <http://www.pge.com/tariffs/ERS.SHTML#ERS>. For comparison purposes, generation rates are listed under the "Unbundling of Total Rates", which is found after the listing of "Total Rates". All other charges which comprise PG&E's "bundled" charges (such as distribution, transmission, tiering adjustments, and other charges) are assessed equally to MCE customers.

Power Charge Indifference Adjustment and Franchise Fee

PG&E Power Charge Indifference Adjustment Rates

The Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (PCIA) is a fee collected by PG&E and assessed to customers who receive their electric generation services from another provider. The PCIA is essentially an “exit fee” assessed by PG&E to cover costs for resources acquired prior to a customer’s change in service providers. PG&E assigns customers a “PCIA Vintage” based on the date the community in where they reside enrolled in alternative service; this date is reset upon reenrollment if a customer opts-out and later re-enrolls in MCE service. PCIA rates are generally updated by PG&E each January. The PCIA is charged on a per kWh basis, based off net monthly usage and is unaffected by time-of-use.

Franchise Fee

The Franchise Fee is collected by PG&E to pay for the right to use public streets to run gas and electric service through. This fee is imposed by cities and counties for all customers (including PG&E-only customers) but is collected separately from CCA customers. The Franchise Fee is charged on a per kWh basis, based off net monthly usage and is unaffected by time-of-use.
